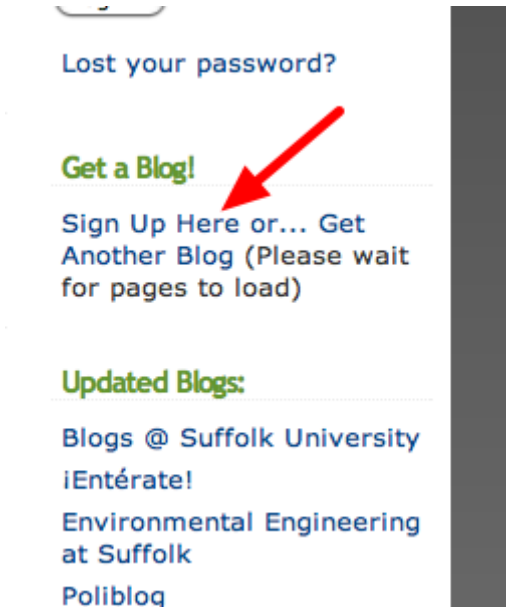


How do I create just a username and no blog?

Get a Username only (if you've never created one) to be added to a course group blog or another existing blog

1. Go to the homepage at <http://blogs.cas.suffolk.edu> and click Sign Up Here

2. Add a Username, your Suffolk email, verify, and click JUST A USERNAME, please.

1. Add a username like firstname lastinitial or lastinitial firstname or something of your choosing
 2. This must be your Suffolk email
 3. Enter the code
 4. Change this option to Just a Username
 5. Click Next
- Wait for the page to load!

3. A confirmation page will tell you to check your email and click a link to activate

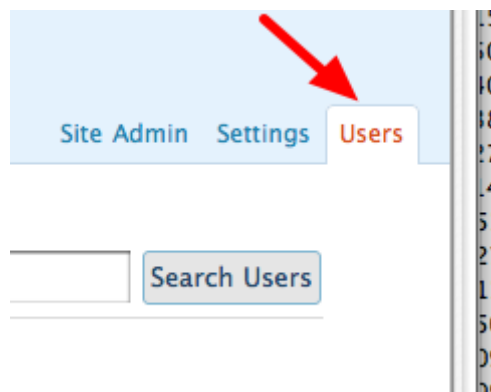

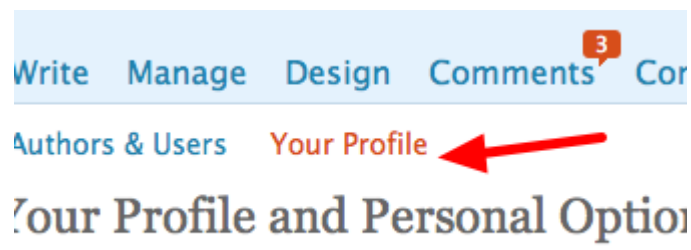
